Is swimwear claimable?

Maybe. Only in cases where items are custom made, not generic store-bought swimwear.

I need a watch for work, can I deduct it?

Go for it! For workers hired on a time basis, like lap dances and privates.

How about glasses?

Possibly. Only if they are for costume purposes.

Prescription glasses and contacts are not deductible.

Can I claim costumes and gowns?

YES! Any custom-made costumes, costumes from sex shops, gowns/dresses made for club work, etc. Can be claimed.

For full-service workers two dresses as a standard per year would be claimable, not limited to custom made, these may be purchased from regular stores.

And for lingerie/latex outfits?

They're claimable! They must be of high quality, at a minimum from bras & Things.

What about jackets and coats?

Yep! One per year for full service out call workers.

Designer shoes, bags, and clothes?

Maybe. In limited circumstances for full-service workers where clients book you to attend an event which requires a specific type of dress code.

Pleasers, boots, latex, etc.?

Claim them! All purchases of industry specific shoes are claimable.
